The fund seeks long-term growth of capital through investments primarily in the common stocks of established companies throughout the world, including the U.S.

Invest in a variety of industries in developed and, to a lesser extent, emerging markets.

Invest in firms taking market share in the global economy and demonstrating strong free cash flow, sustainable margins, long product cycles, and experienced management teams.

The percentage of assets invested in U.S. and foreign stocks will normally be at least 80% of net assets and will vary over time according to the manager's outlook.

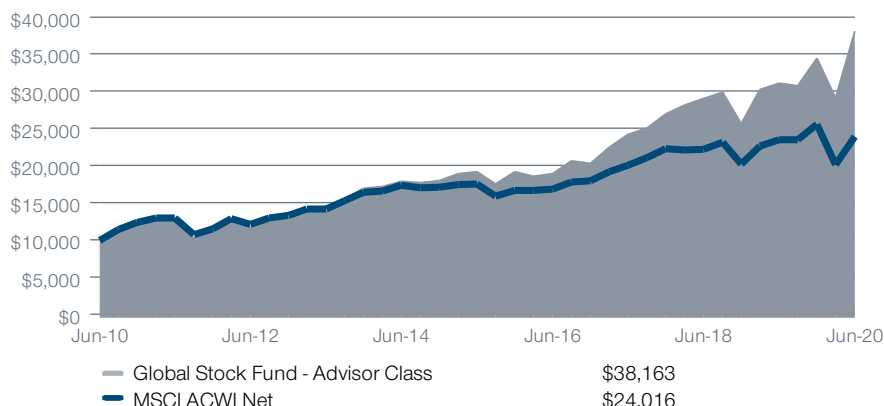

Definitions

Beta: A measure of market risk of an investment option that shows how responsive the investment is to a given market index, such as the Standard & Poor's 500 Index. By definition, the beta of the benchmark is 1.00. An investment with a beta of 1.10 is expected to perform 10% better than the index in up markets and 10% worse in down markets. Usually, higher betas represent riskier investments. Figures are calculated using monthly data and are net of fees.

Additional Disclosures

Morningstar rated the fund 5, 5, and 5 stars among 761, 626 and 367 World Large Stock funds for the 3-, 5-, and 10-year periods (as applicable) ending 6/30/2020, respectively. The Morningstar Rating™ for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. Exchange-traded funds and open-ended mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes. It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a managed product's monthly excess performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of products in each product category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.

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Unless otherwise noted, index returns are shown with gross dividends reinvested.
